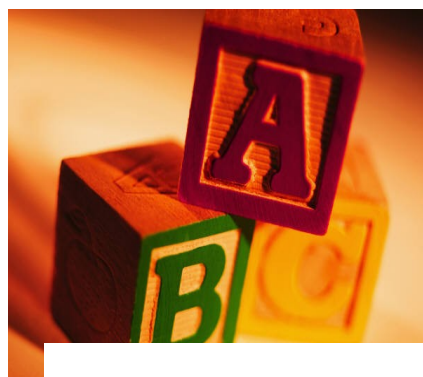

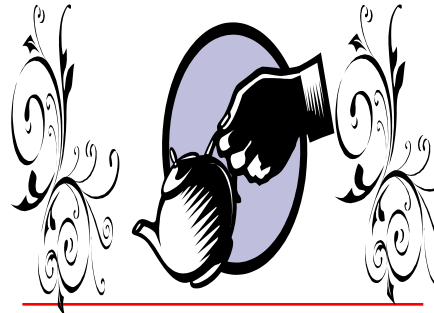


Mini Miracle of the Month

Congratulations to Amaurien Tolliver!!! He is our Mini Miracles of the Month.

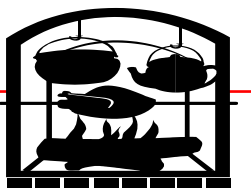
